

### FOR YOUR SAFETY


If you smell gas:





## 1. Assembly body supports to body





● M4 X 4Pcs



**4. Place the cooking grids.**





**5. Put in the warming rack using the holes provided.**




## 6. Install the charcoal basket


a. Remove the cooking grid




b. And then take out 2pcs of Flame tamer



d. Put the cooking grid back in position




c. Place the charcoal basket inside the barbecue body

**7. Unscrew ignition cap and place a Battery (Size: AA, not provided ) into place with the (+) end facing outwards. Screw cap back on. Upon pressing the ignition button, a clicking sound will be heard. This is the ignition spark that can be heard.**
